2010 STATISTICAL SUMMARY

**END STAGE RENAL DISEASE
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NETWORK OF NEW ENGLAND ESRD STATISTICS

Each year, the Network of New England prepares a statistical summary report of the most frequently requested demographic information related to the ESRD patient population in the six New England states. This 2010 statistical report contains data displayed for each of the six states and this Network. Several of the tables and figures have trend data for the past several years which provides a historical picture of the continuous growth for ESRD providers offering dialysis and kidney transplantation services to an increasing number of individuals requiring these life-sustaining services.

HIGHLIGHTS:

❑ **New ESRD Patients Initiating Dialysis – Page 3**

Data are reported by the first outpatient facility providing chronic dialysis. The average age of these patients continues to rise. In 1989, the average age for new patients was 56; in 2010, it is 65.3, 65.32an indicator of a more complex patient population requiring additional geriatric clinical services.

❑ **Prevalence of ESRD Dialysis Patients by State of Provider – Page 4**

In the mid 1990s, an annual increase in the number of dialysis patients was observed at approximately 6% to 9% per year. However, the annual prevalence growth in recent years for New England has been around 3%, with an increase of 2.98% between 2009 and 2010.

❑ **Dialysis Patient Characteristics – Page 5**

In 2010, 39.3% of dialysis patients have diabetes as their primary cause of renal failure, followed by 22.2% with hypertension. More males (57%) than females (43%) are on dialysis. More than half of total prevalent patients (52.3%) were age 65 or older.

❑ **In-center & Home Patients in New England – Pages 6 - 14**

Number of patients by dialysis provider is displayed by state.

❑ **ESRD Resources in New England as of 12/31/10 – Page 15**

The number of ESRD providers increased by 1.8% in 2010. This table lists the number of ESRD providers and the number of chronic dialysis treatment stations by state and Network.

❑ **2010 Dialysis Prevalence by Modality: State and Network – Page 16**

This Network has 9.8% of the dialysis population receiving home dialysis. There is a wide variation among the states in the proportion of patients at home. For 2010, the lowest is Rhode Island (2.3%) and the highest is Connecticut (18.3%).

❑ **Crude Dialysis Mortality Rate – Page 17**

The annual unadjusted mortality rate for the dialysis population is showing a slow decline for Network. The Network's crude death rate in 2010 was at 19.99%. The leading cause of death in 2010 was cardiac related events.

❑ **Transplant Data by Year – Pages 18 & 19**

This table reports the number of kidney transplants performed by each transplant center in New England between 1989– 2010. The total number of transplants performed annually increased in 2010 compared to previous years.

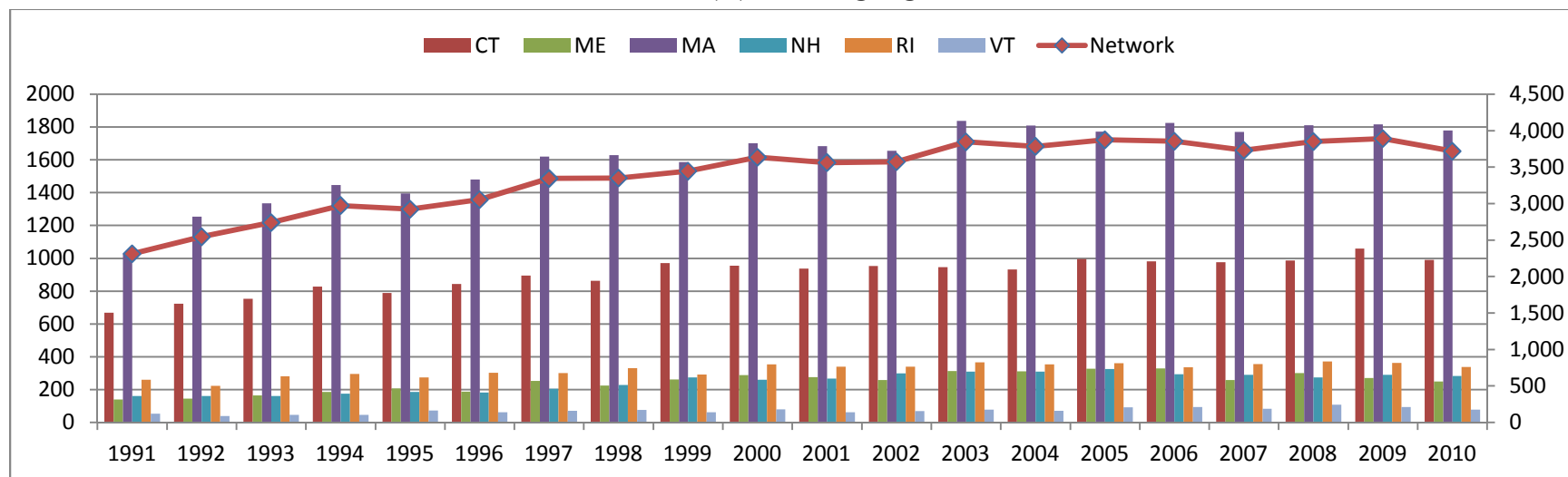
❑ **Kidney Transplantation by Donor Type – Page 20**

In 2010, 45.0% of the transplants performed were from living (related and non-related) donors. This is a decrease of 0.7% from last year. There is an increase in deceased donor transplantation from 54.2% to 54.7%.

❑ **Vocational Rehabilitation – Page 21**

The annual 2010 facility survey indicated that 28.7% of ESRD patients between the ages of 18–54 received either vocational rehabilitation services, or were full-time or part-time employees, or students. The number of facilities that provide shifts after 5 PM in 2010 was 36%.

New ESRD Patients Initiating Dialysis by State of Provider 1991 – 2010

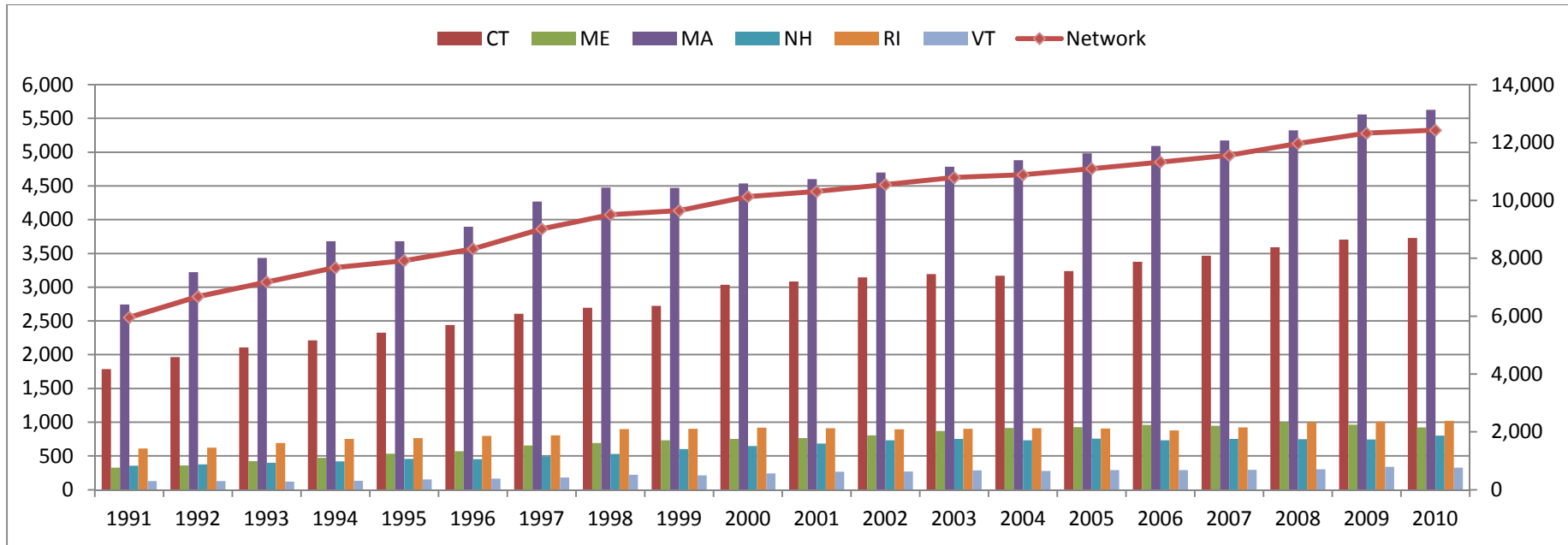

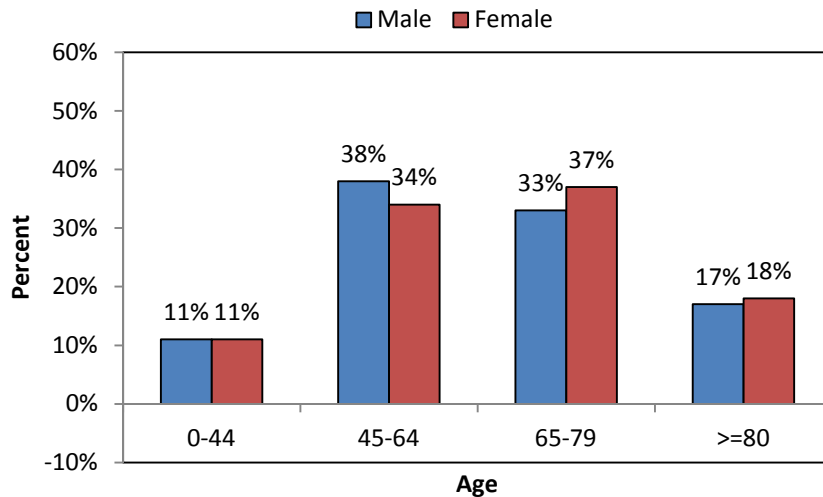

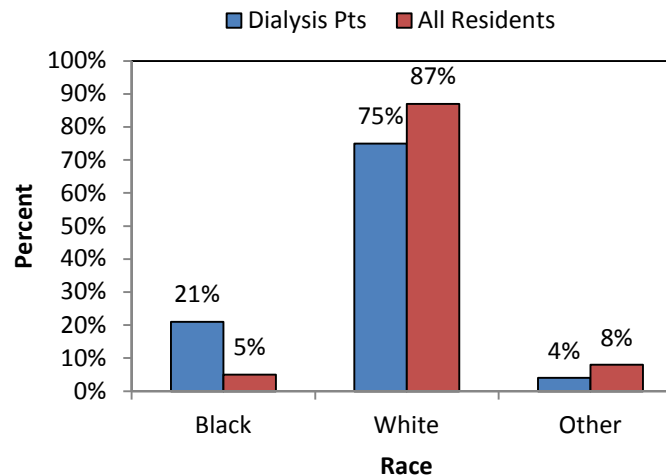
Dialysis Patient Characteristics in New England

Dialysis Population 12/31/10

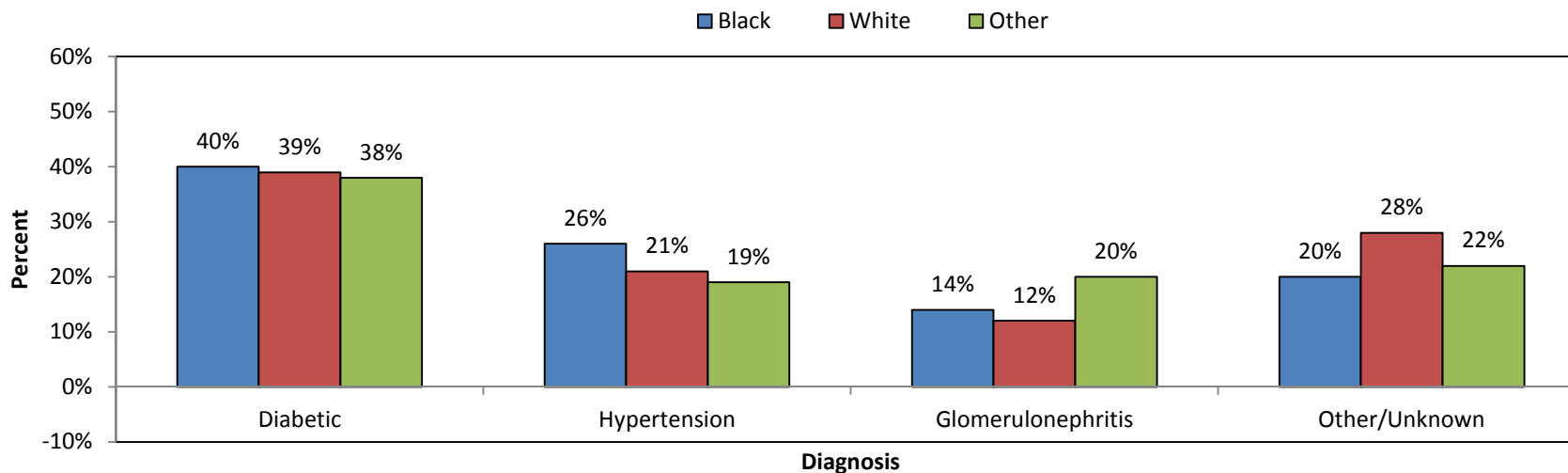
Age Distribution of New England Dialysis Population

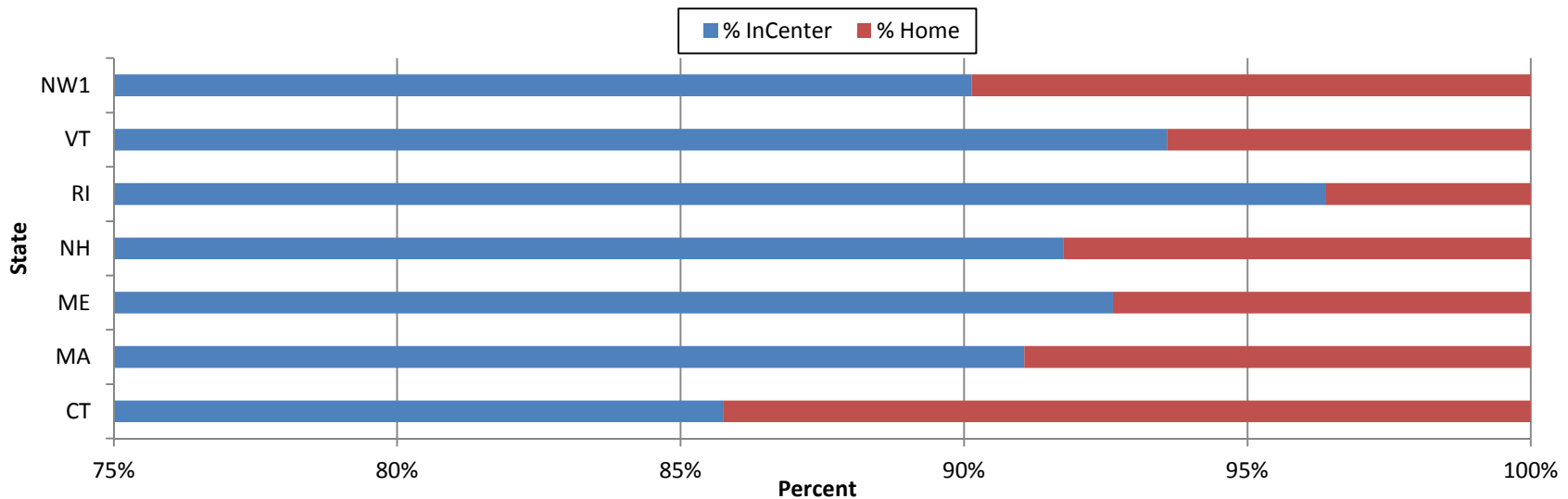

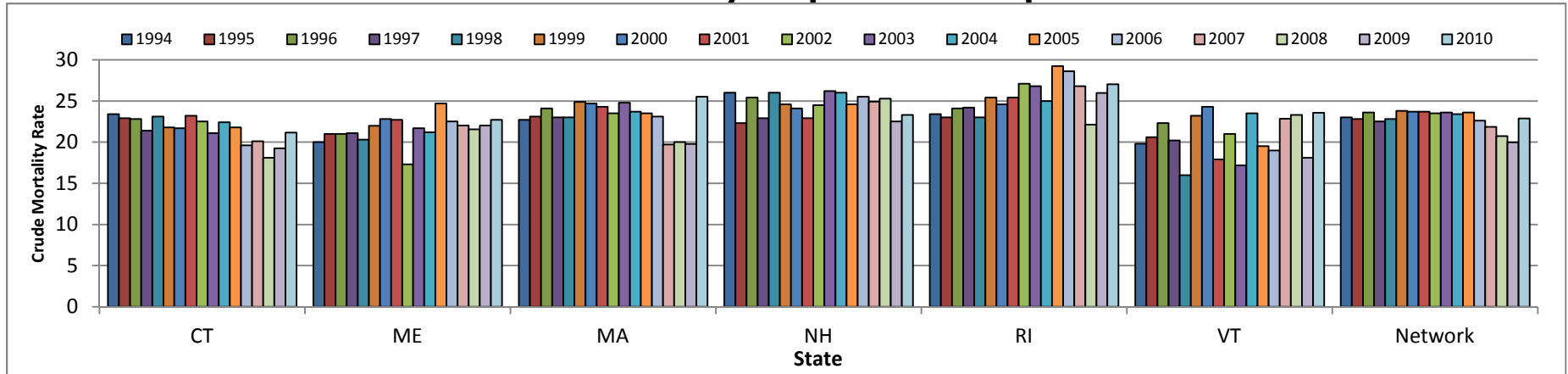

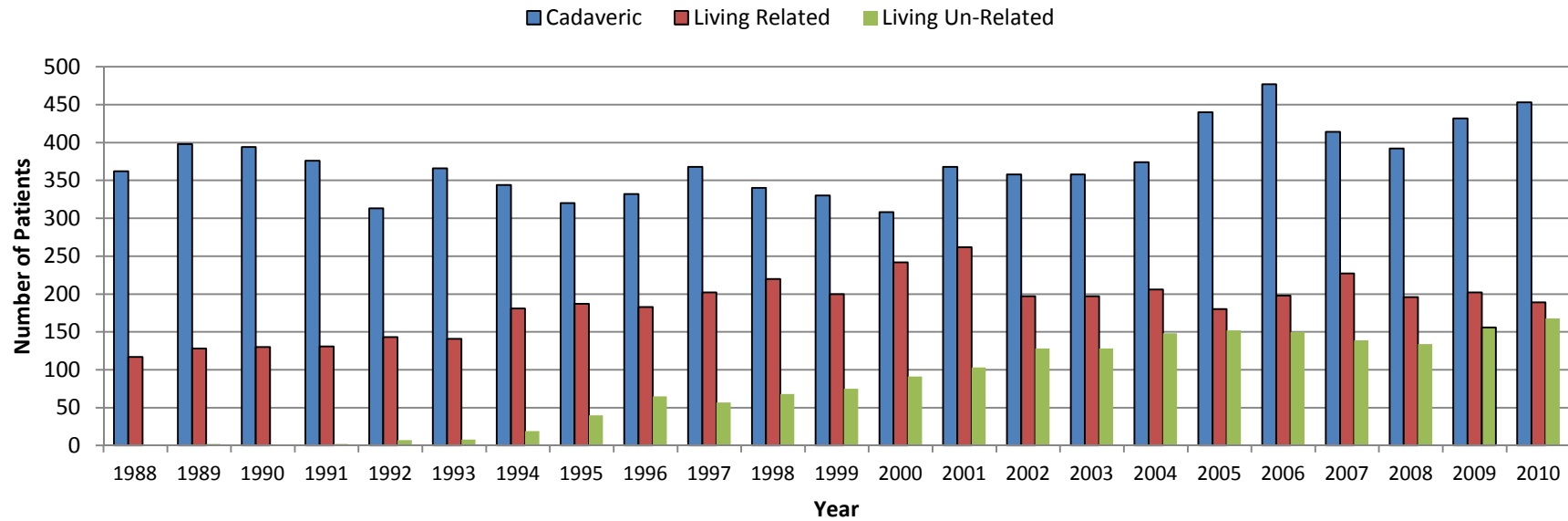
